Seattle Department of Constructions and Inspections (SDCI) is poised to approve the removal of Astra, a huge, healthy, 100-year-old western red cedar. Astra lives 8 blocks away from and is the same species as Luma, Wedgwood's famous tree.

SDCI MUST FOLLOW THEIR OLD TREE CODE

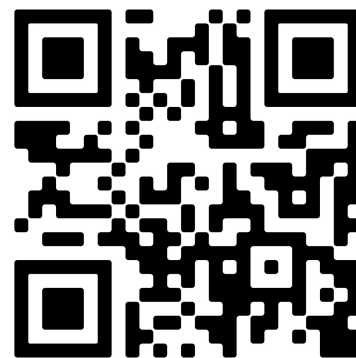
- Because this project started **before** the new tree code was passed, SDCI is required to vest this project to the old tree code.
- The old tree code says that trees should only be removed for development **when necessary**
- Astra lives on the edge of a lot. Architects have told us there are many more options to retain Astra while building the same housing.
- Astra's case is about asking SDCI **to prioritize livable homes over developer interests**. Help us stand up to powerful interests to protect our environment.
